4. College academic transcript(s) showing a preferred GPA of 3.3 or higher (Student copy for Barnard transcript, official for all other institutions).
5. A current résumé.
6. Applicants should be available to be interviewed by appointment.
7. Full-time enrollment (12+ credits per semester) for the 2017-2018 academic year.
8. Enrolled in or planning to enroll in a Science Education or Mathematics Education Urban Teaching minor.
9. Three reference letters from professors or employers, commenting on your overall academic performance, ability to work on a team, and potential as a full-time science or mathematics teacher **along with** completed recommender's forms for each.
10. Agreement to teach full-time for *two* years in a high-need school district for each year of Noyce Scholarship or Stipend received (to be completed after award selection).
11. Signed Promissory Note and Agreement to repay the amount of the Scholarship or Stipend received if full-time teaching services are not met within eight years (to be completed after award selection)
